ENTER SELECTION:		

- Shift F2 to delete the child entity
- The information will disappear.
- F1 to back out of the 1st screen, you will be on the war_id number
- Shift F2 to delete the information in the next screen
- F1 to back out of the second screen
- Do a search for the warrant number you should have deleted to confirm
- If the information appears then repeat the previous process if it continues to not go away someone has this table locked. You will need to ask if anyone is in, or just wait for the next day.
