- Go to Direct Table Access > Warrant Table and Child
- search war_id for the warrant number (13591 in this example)

ENTER SELECTION:			

- **Shift F2** to delete the child entity
- The information will disappear.
- **F1** to back out of the 1st screen, you will be on the war_id number
- **Shift F2** to delete the information in the next screen
- **F1** to back out of the second screen
- Do a search for the warrant number you should have deleted to confirm
- If the information appears then repeat the previous process - if it continues to not go away someone has this table locked. You will need to ask if anyone is in, or just wait for the next day.
